



Newly Accepted Students 60-Day Mutual Evaluation Policy

(updated 08.10.21)

The Waldorf School of Pittsburgh recognizes that given COVID-19, our standard admissions process including an in-person tour, interview, and child visit may not be possible. Additionally, new applicants may not be able to submit a full school transcript as part of their application for a variety of circumstances. As such for the coming school year for **all newly accepted students in which this is the first time the student is enrolled at WSP**, we have adopted the following:

- A 60-day mutual evaluation period which starts on the first day a child is in school with in-person instruction. The trial period is 60 calendar days.
- A follow up meeting or meetings may take place at any time during this time period as requested by the school or guardian(s). These meetings are to include at least the main teacher and a guardian, but may include Faculty Chairs or Administrators as needed.
- If either party feels that the admission is not a good fit during the 60 calendar days, the tuition agreement can be terminated and the child will no longer be considered an enrolled student. A family will not be contractually obligated for the remainder of the school year. No refunds will be issued for current months enrolled or any payment plan fees.
- At the conclusion of the evaluation period, written notification will be given by the Office of Admissions.
